HEMP PULP	vs.	WOOD PULP
More durable: longer, stronger & stiffer		Wood pulp fibers are generally shorter & have weaker formations
Hemp pulp is naturally brighter than wood pulp without chemical bleaching		Wood pulp requires chemical bleaching to achieve its white color
Hemp pulp contains 30% less lignin than wood, making it easier to break down into pulp to make paper		Wood must be treated with chemicals to remove the lignin
Hemp paper can be recycled 7 to 8 times due to stronger, more durable fibers		Wood pulp is limited to being recycled about 3 times
Using hemp fibers reduces the negative pollution & environmental effects of 'tree-based' paper		Clear-cutting trees damages the soil causing slower growth rates and lesser trees to absorb CO2
1 acre of hemp can produce about the same amount of paper as 4-20 acres of trees		Deforestation leads to the destruction of indigenous habitats
